SUBJECT: Approval of Specified Contracts Pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 6008.6

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This item requests approval to execute contracts for goods or services with a value in excess of \$50,000; or, for information technology (IT) goods and services, in excess of \$100,000.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

Should the Contracts Committee concur in the proposed action, the Contracts Committee approves execution of the contracts listed herein.

DISCUSSION

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6008.6, the State Bar shall award no contract for goods, services, or both, for an aggregate amount in excess of \$50,000, or for information technology goods, services, or both, for an aggregate amount in excess of \$100,000, except pursuant to the standards established in Article 4 (commencing with section 10335) of Chapter 2 of Part 2 of Division 2 of the Public Contract Code and approval of the Board of Trustees.

Pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6026.7(c)(3), a closed session may be held for those meetings relating to the preparation of examination materials or the approval, the grading, or the security of test administration of the California Bar Examination or the First-Year Law Students' Examination.

The contract listed below is in excess of \$50,000 and has met the standards established by Article 4 of the Public Contract Code, as implemented through the State Bar's

Procurement Policy. This contract requires approval by the Board of Trustees in order to be executed.

FISCAL/PERSONNEL IMPACT

The Board of Trustees approved a \$4.1 million master services agreement with Measure Learning at its September 19, 2024, meeting. That amount assumed a \$2.4 million cost for administration of the July 2025 bar exam. With the contracts brought forward for approval on April 2, 2025, and items 1–3 today, the July 2025 exam is now projected to cost at least \$4.75 million, over \$2 million in excess of the originally budgeted amount. These expenses will be compounded by revenue losses stemming from expansive fee waivers offered for February 2025 exam takers and registrants.

Item #4 is part of core business operations in the Office of Admissions and is included in the annual budget.
