

**Proposed Rule 2.11 of the Rules of the State Bar
(Redline Version)**

Rule 2.11 Due date; Form of payment

- (A) A licensee must pay the annual license fees set forth in the Schedule of Charges and Deadlines each calendar year ~~no later than February 1~~ on or before the deadline set forth in the Schedule of Charges and Deadlines.
- (B) The State Bar is authorized to prescribe acceptable methods for the payment of annual license fees. Any attempted payment that does not conform to a method prescribed by the State Bar may be rejected. If a licensee does not cure a nonconforming payment, the State Bar may nevertheless process the nonconforming payment before or after the ~~February 1~~ deadline set forth in the Schedule of Charges and Deadlines. Nonconforming payments that are not cured by the licensee or processed by the State Bar by the ~~February 1~~ deadline subject the licensee to the penalties set forth in rule 2.13 or suspension in accordance with rule 2.33.
