



- First all multiple-choice exam administration
- 100 multiple-choice questions divided into two 90-minute sessions

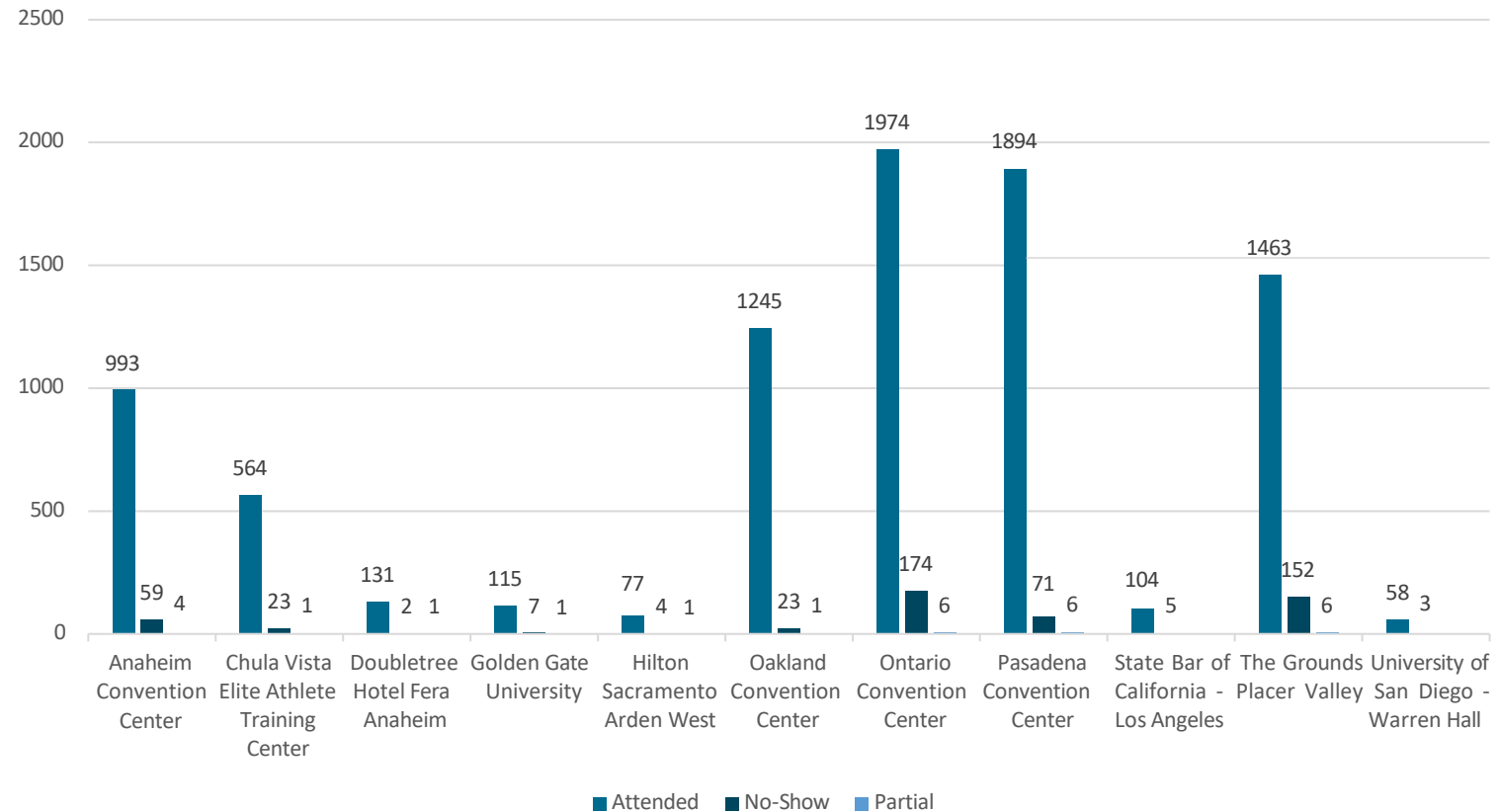

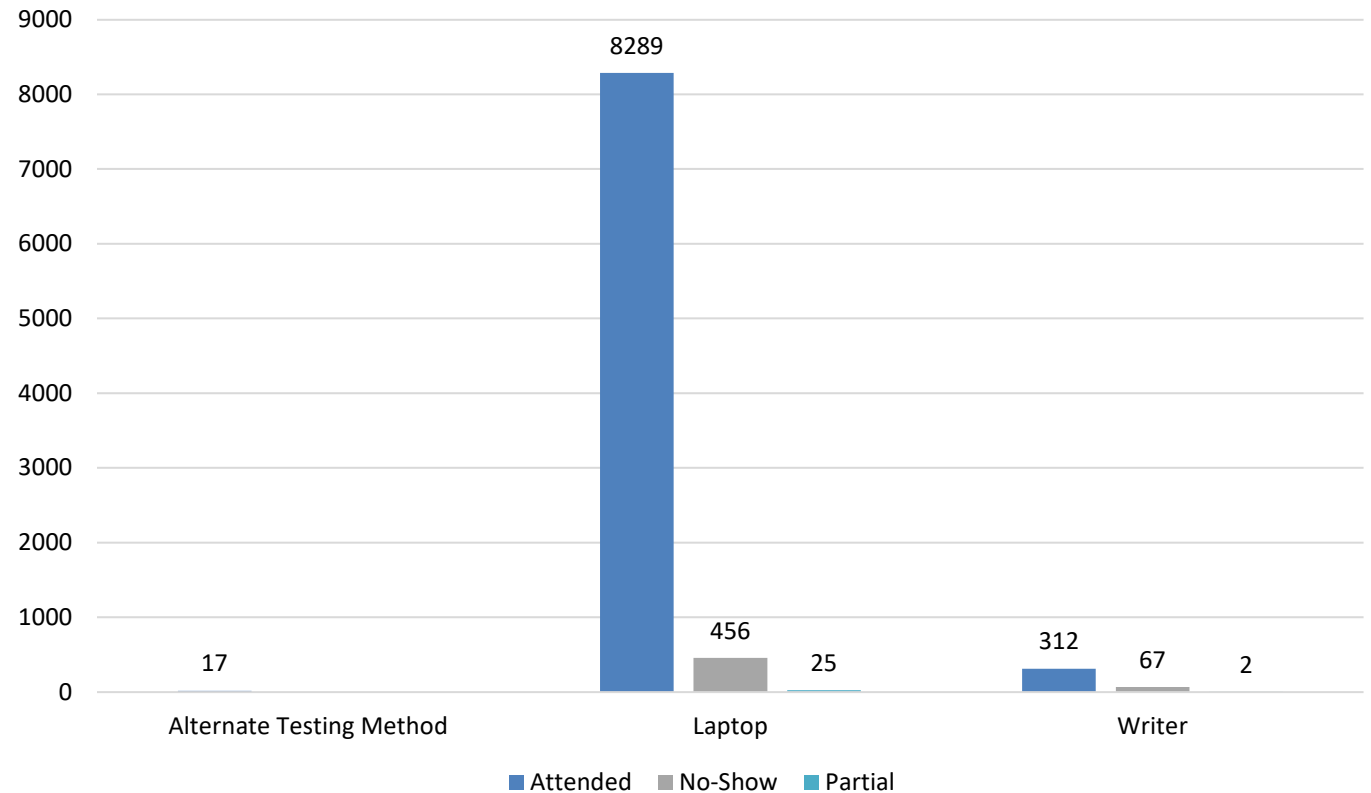

July 2024 CBX Attendance Details by Test Method

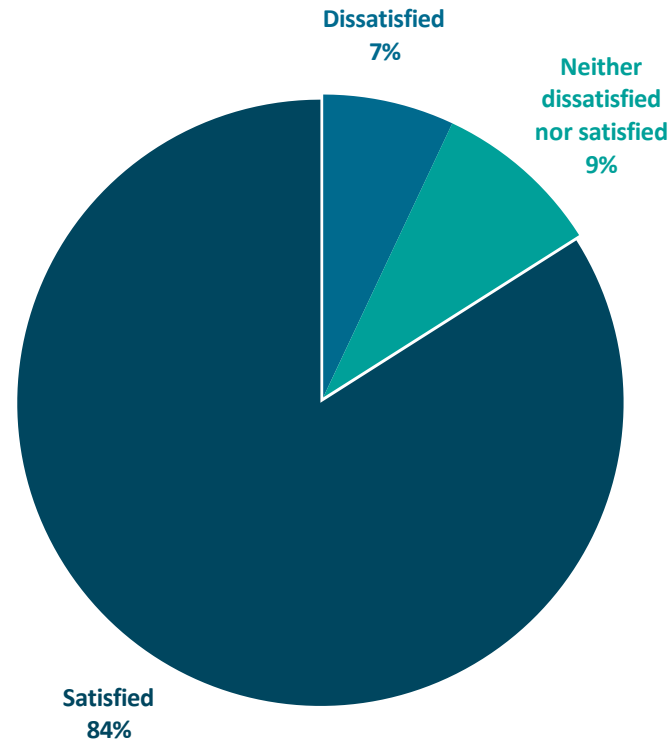




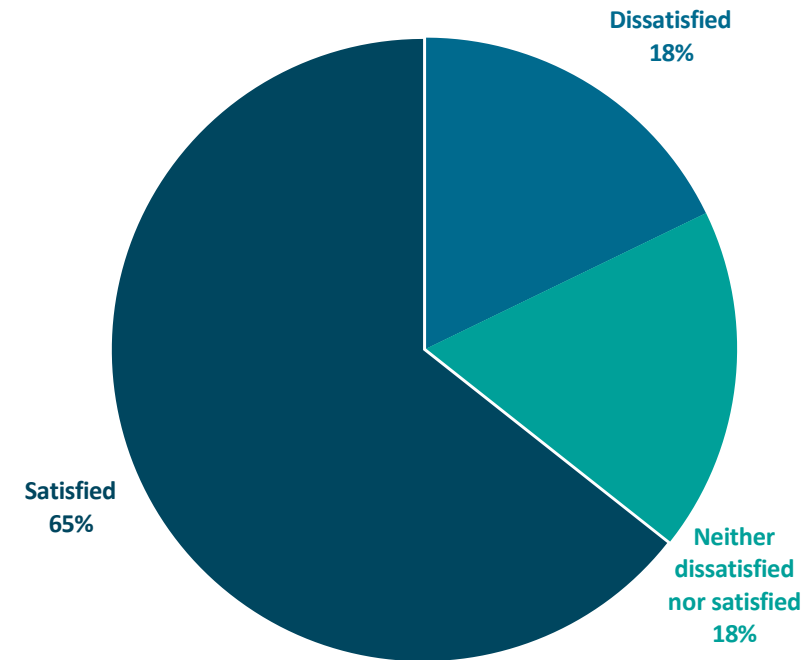
# Preliminary June FYLSX Survey Findings

# Preliminary June FYLSX Survey Findings

## Test Center Sentiment

- 91% agreed staff at the test center were professional.
- 78% agreed it was easy to secure a seat at a test center near them.
- 76% agreed it was easy to find transportation to or to travel to the test center.

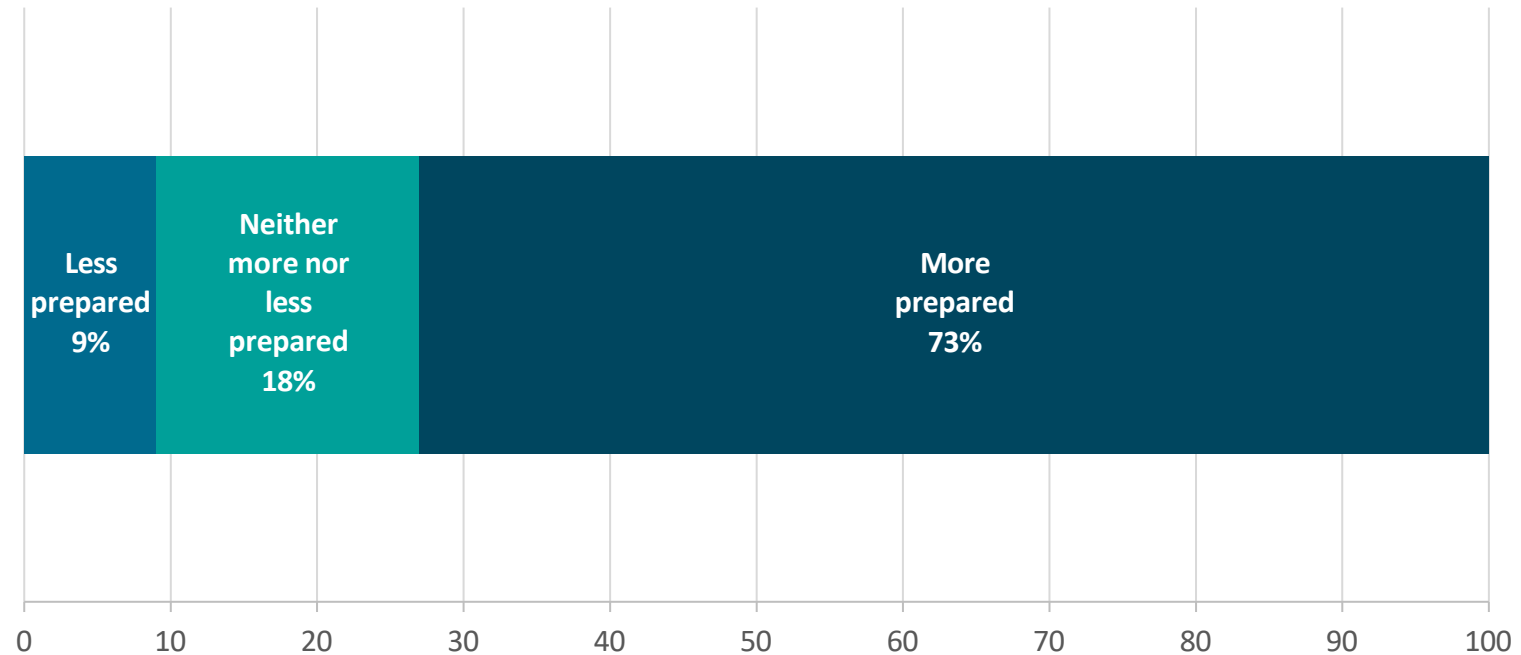
## Remote Exam Sentiment

- 68% agreed the environment scan was comfortable to them.



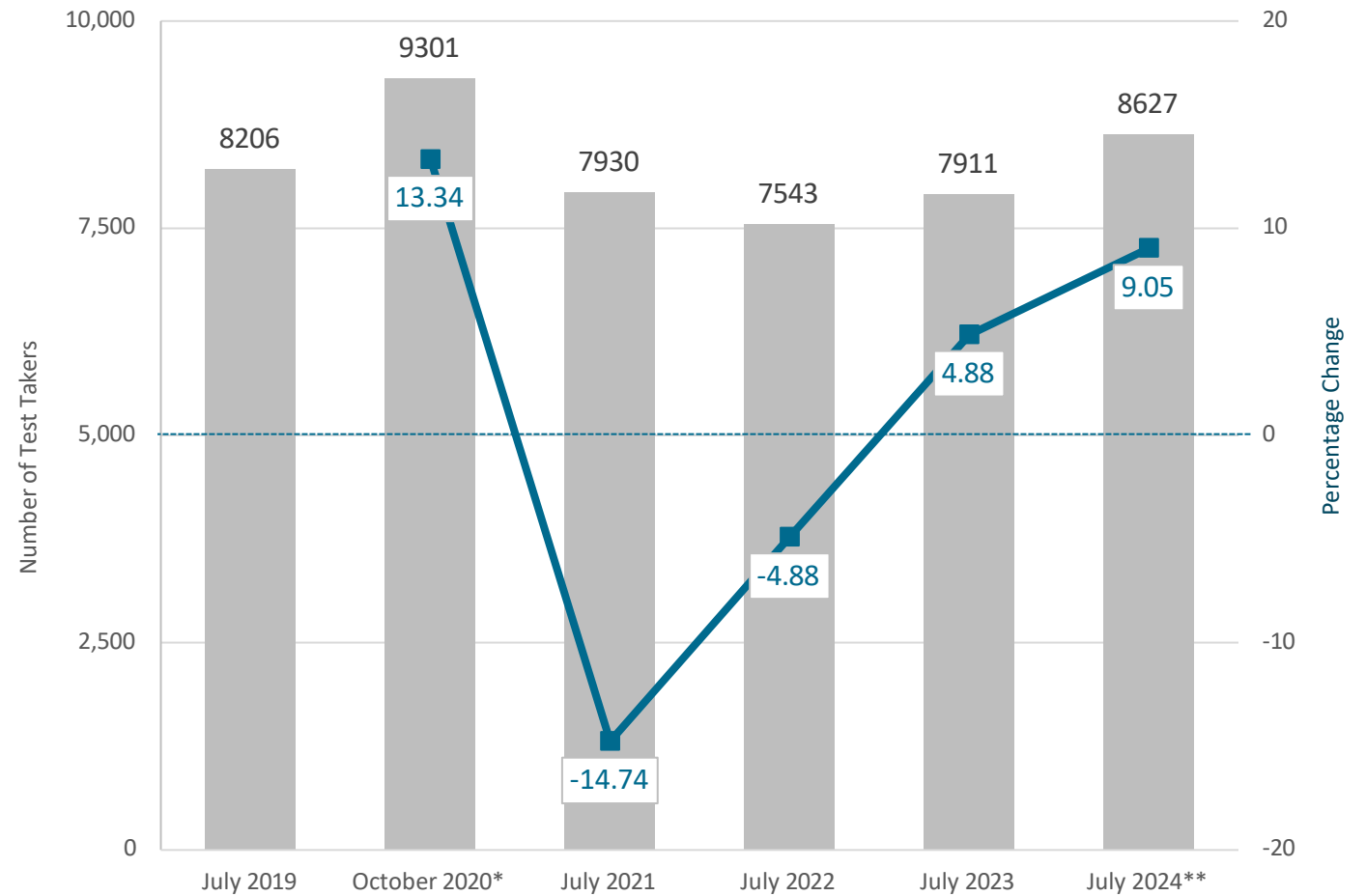
# Preliminary June FYLSX Survey Findings

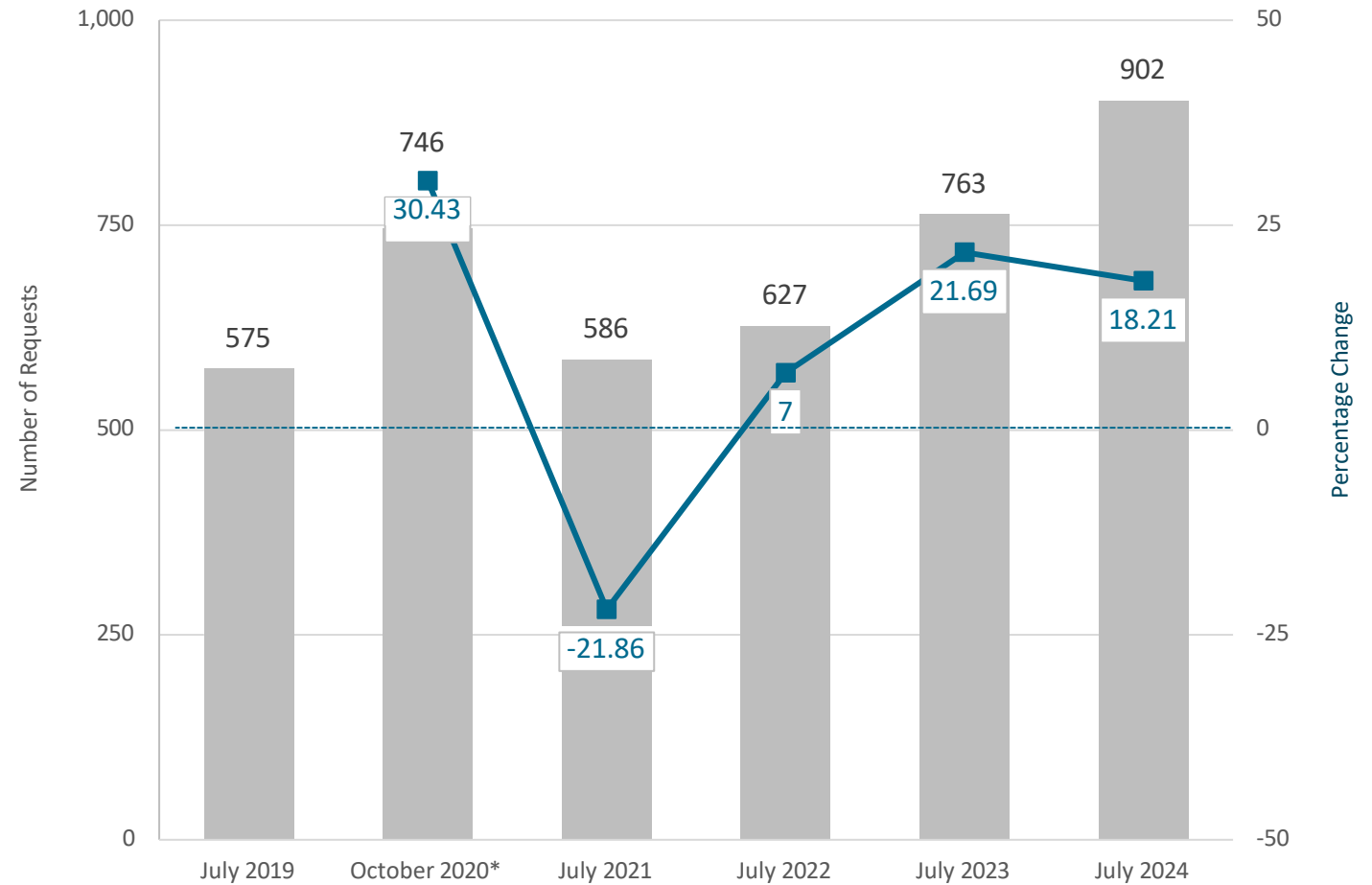

# Updated Testing Accommodations Application

- March 2024, website and hard copy TA application updated with streamlined TA process
- August 16, 2024, TA application in the Applicant Portal (electronic application) updated to the new format
  - Reduces the costs and time spent securing documentation to support the TA request
  - Asks specific questions to the applicant's qualified professional to determine an applicant's disability-related functional limitations, their specific access needs, and how those needs relate to the testing accommodations requested
